- ✓ Our God is a God of Order
- ✓ Our God is an Unchanging God
- ✓ God Himself has No Beginning or End
- ✓ Our God is Not Bound by Space or Time
- ✓ Our God doesn't have an idol or an image. He is a Jealous God
- ✓ God is "all-powerful, all-knowing, and everywhere present." He is Omnipotent, Omniscient, and the Omnipresent God.
- ✓ God is Spirit.
- ✓ God has a personality.
- ✓ He is addressed as a Person and possesses all the attributes of personality.
- ✓ He is an intelligent and moral Being whom we can trust, love and praise.
- ✓ There is none to control Him.

- ✓ There is no other like Him who is "glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders".

incense, which are the prayers of the saints (God's people). ⁹ And they sang a new song [of glorious redemption], saying,

"Worthy and deserving are You to take the scroll and to break its seals; for You were slain (sacrificed), and with Your blood You purchased people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.

2 Therefore if there is any encouragement and comfort in Christ [as there certainly is in abundance], if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship [that we share] in the Spirit, if [there is] any [great depth of] affection and compassion, ² make my joy complete by being of the same mind, having the same [a]love [toward one another], knit together in spirit, intent on one purpose [and living a life that reflects your faith and spreads the gospel the good news regarding salvation through faith in Christ]. ³ Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit [through factional motives, or strife], but with [an attitude of humility [being neither arrogant nor self-righteous], regard others as more important than yourselves. ⁴ Do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. ⁵ Have this same attitude in yourselves which was in Christ Jesus [look to Him as your example in selfless humility], ⁶ who, although He existed in the form and unchanging essence of God [as One with Him, possessing the fullness of all the divine attributes—the entire nature of deity], did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped or asserted [as if He did not already possess it, or was afraid of losing it]; ⁷ but emptied Himself [without renouncing or diminishing His deity, but only temporarily giving up the outward expression of divine equality and His rightful dignity] by assuming the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men [He became completely human but was without sin, being fully God and fully man]. 8 After He was found in [terms of His] outward appearance as a man [for a divinely-appointed time], He humbled Himself [still further] by becoming obedient [to the Father] to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 For this reason also [because He obeyed and so completely humbled Himself], God has highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus [b] EVERY KNEE SHALL BOW [in submission], of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and that every tongue will confess and openly acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord (sovereign God), to the glory of God the Father.

1 The first [a] account I made, Theophilus, was [a continuous report] about all the things that Jesus began to do and to [b] teach 2 until the day when He ascended to heaven, after He had by the Holy Spirit given instruction to the apostles (special messengers) whom He had chosen. 3 To these [men] He also showed Himself alive after His suffering [in Gethsemane and on the cross], by [a series of] many infallible proofs and unquestionable demonstrations, appearing to them over a period of forty days and talking to them about the things concerning the kingdom of God. 4 While being together and eating with them, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Of which," He said, "you have heard Me speak. 5 For John baptized with water, but you will be baptized and empowered and united with the Holy Spirit, not long from now."

⁶ So when they had come together, they asked Him *repeatedly*, "Lord, are You at this time reestablishing the kingdom *and* restoring it to Israel?" ⁷ He said to them, "It is not for you to know the times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority. ⁸ But you will receive power *and* ability when the Holy Spirit comes upon you; and you will be My witnesses [to tell people about Me] both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and Samaria, and even to the ends of the earth."
